Zengzhi Li, born in Anhui, China, 15 January 1946, majored in forestry and forest pest control at Nanjing Forestry University from August, 1963 to 1968 and Fujian Forestry College from March, 1979 to December, 1980, and Visiting scientist of insect mycology at Cornell University from January, 1981 to April, 1983, and at Rothamsted Experimental Station from November, 1991 to August, 1992.

Vice professor at Department of Forestry, Anhui Agricultural University, Chian from April, 1986 to December, 1990; professor at the same university from December, 1990 to March, 2011. Vice president of Anhui Agricultuarl University from March, 1993 to June, 2000, and then president to July, 2007. After retirement from the university, started as the chief scientist of Zhejiang BioAsia Pharmaceutical, director of BioAsia Life Science Institute of Zhejiang, and curator of China Cordyceps Museum.
