Dr. Nigel Hywel-Jones, a British fungal taxonomist, the main founder of the new Cordyceps classification system, and an important member of the One Fungus One (OFN) Working Committee, enjoying a high reputation internationally. He has worked for more than 20 years as the Chief Scientist of the National Center for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology of Thailand, where he has created a world-class repository of fungal strains under his leadership. Published 96 SCI articles in world-class academic journals, and was invited to give 26 conference reports at international academic conferences. Trained and mentored 10 PhDs. Obtained 2 international invention patents. He is currently the vice president of Zhejiang BioAsia Life Science Institute and the director of the Culture Collection Center.
